




in getting there. These sponsors give us some of the tools we need to plan for a successful ASPE year.



The Minnesota Plumbing Board met on 8/29/19 and reviewed the final Request For Actions (RFA's) regarding the possible adoption of the 2018 Uniform Plumbing Code with Minnesota amendments.
