

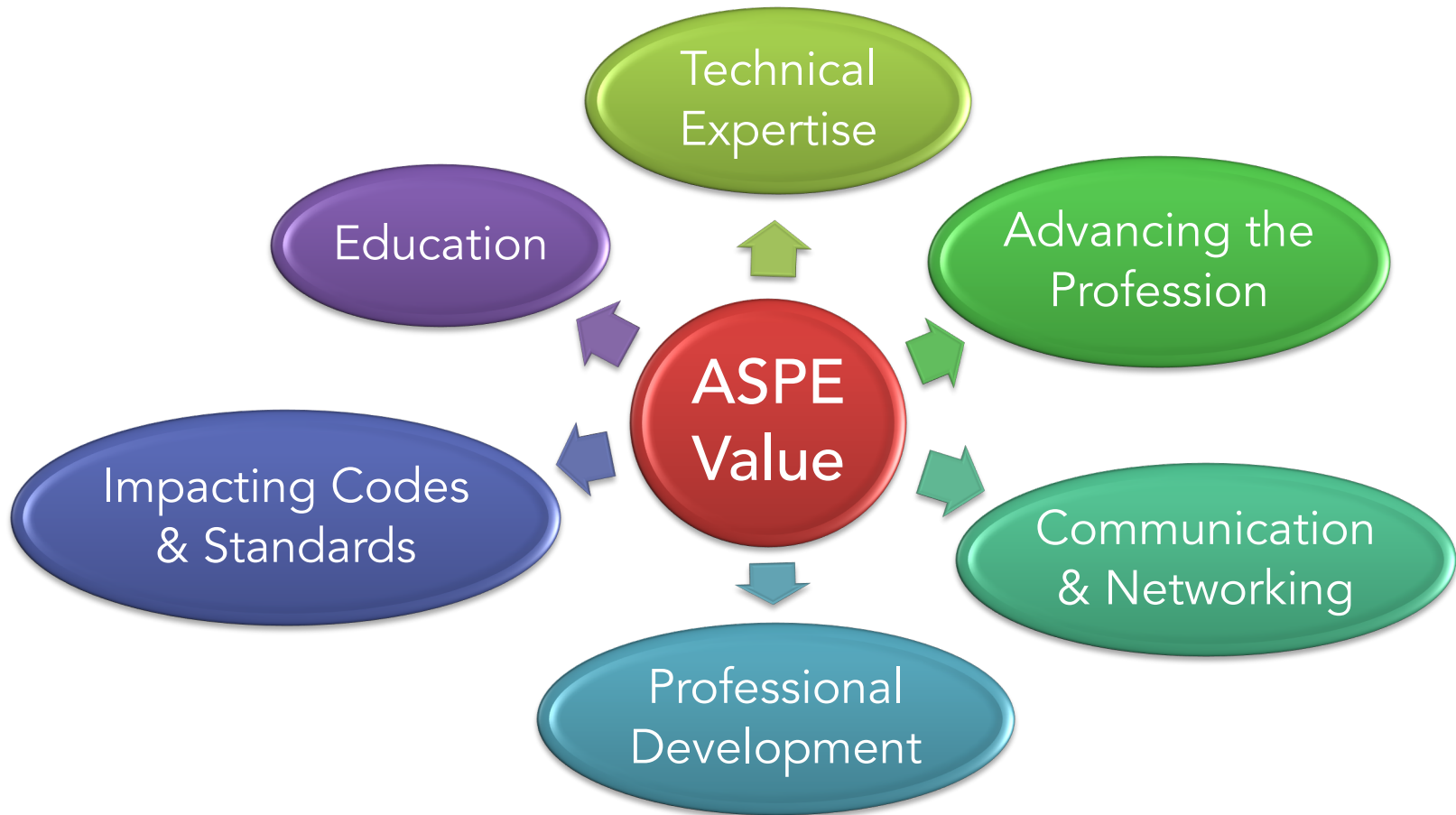

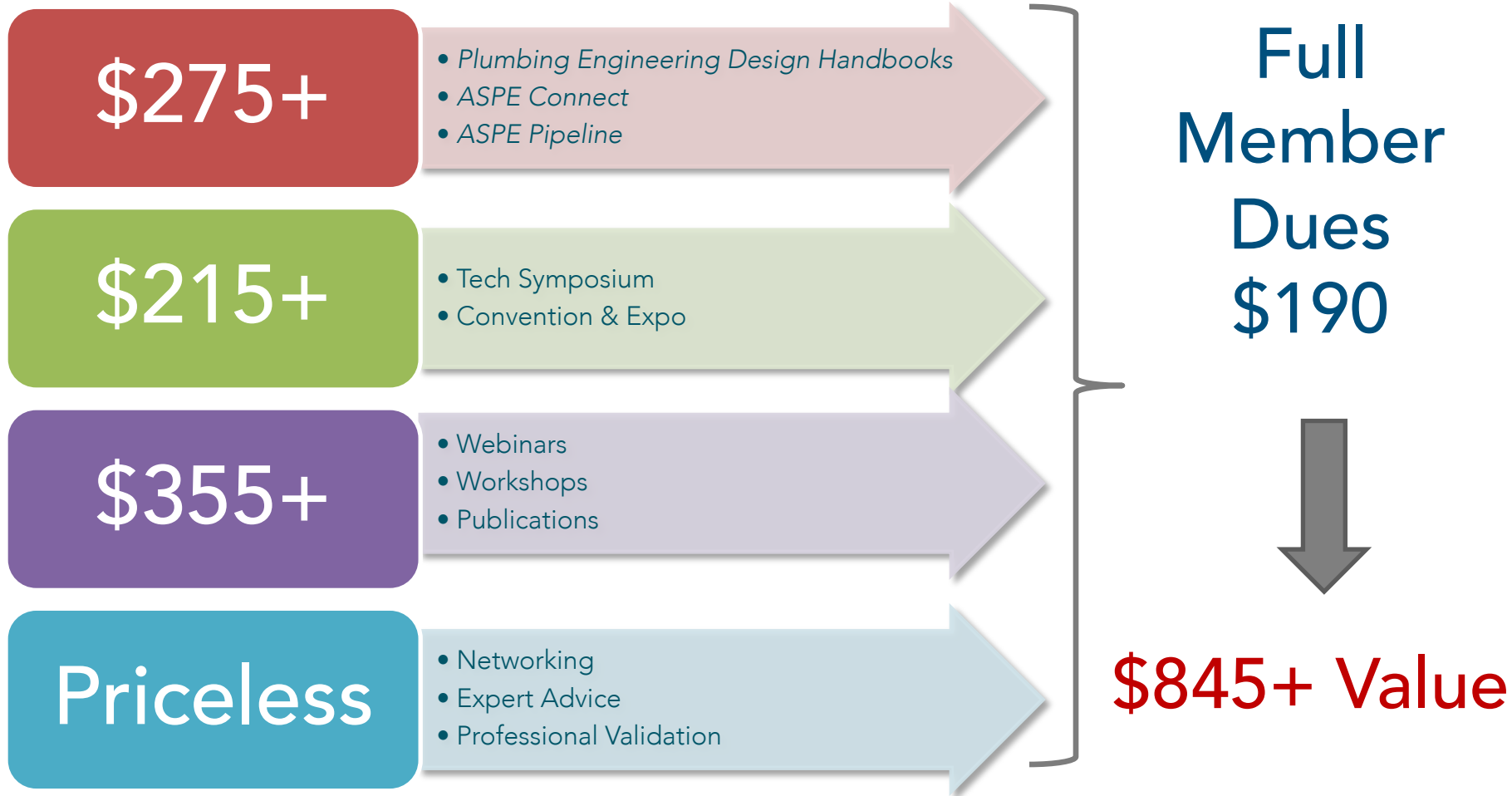
Purpose

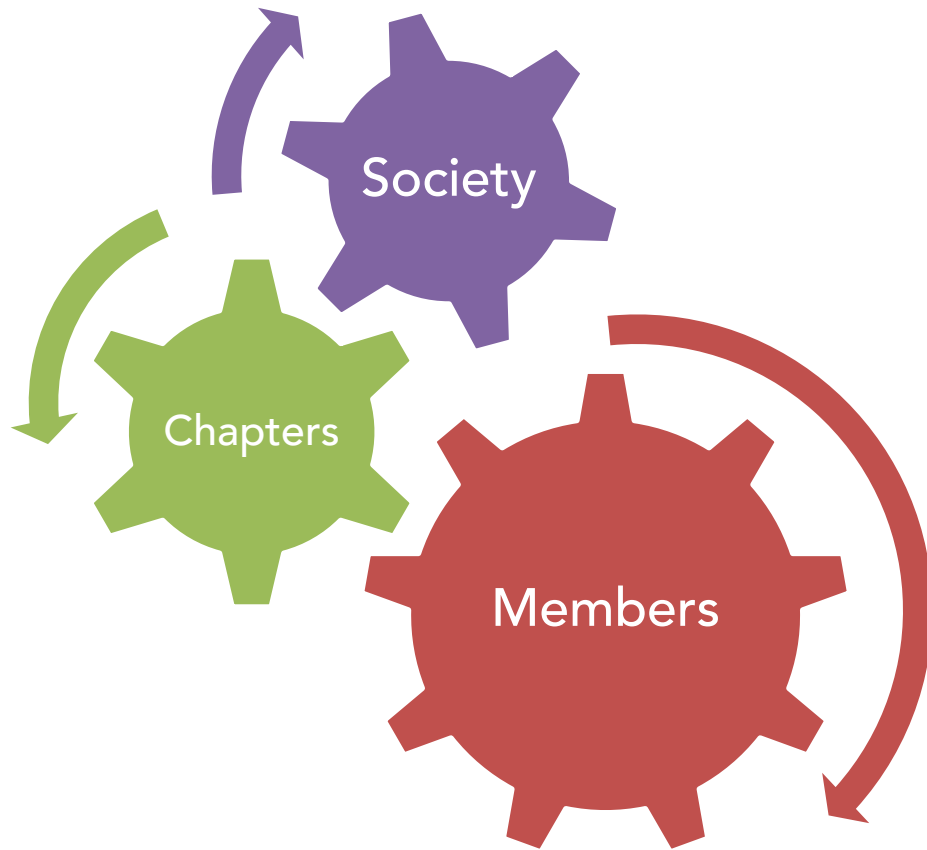

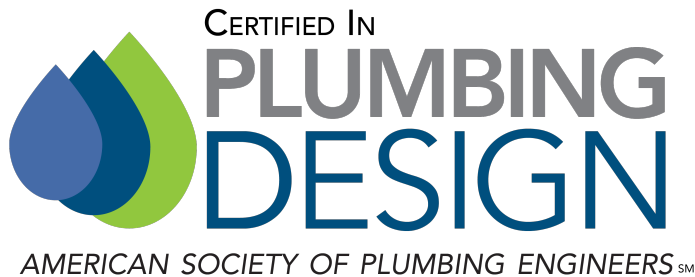

Professional Development

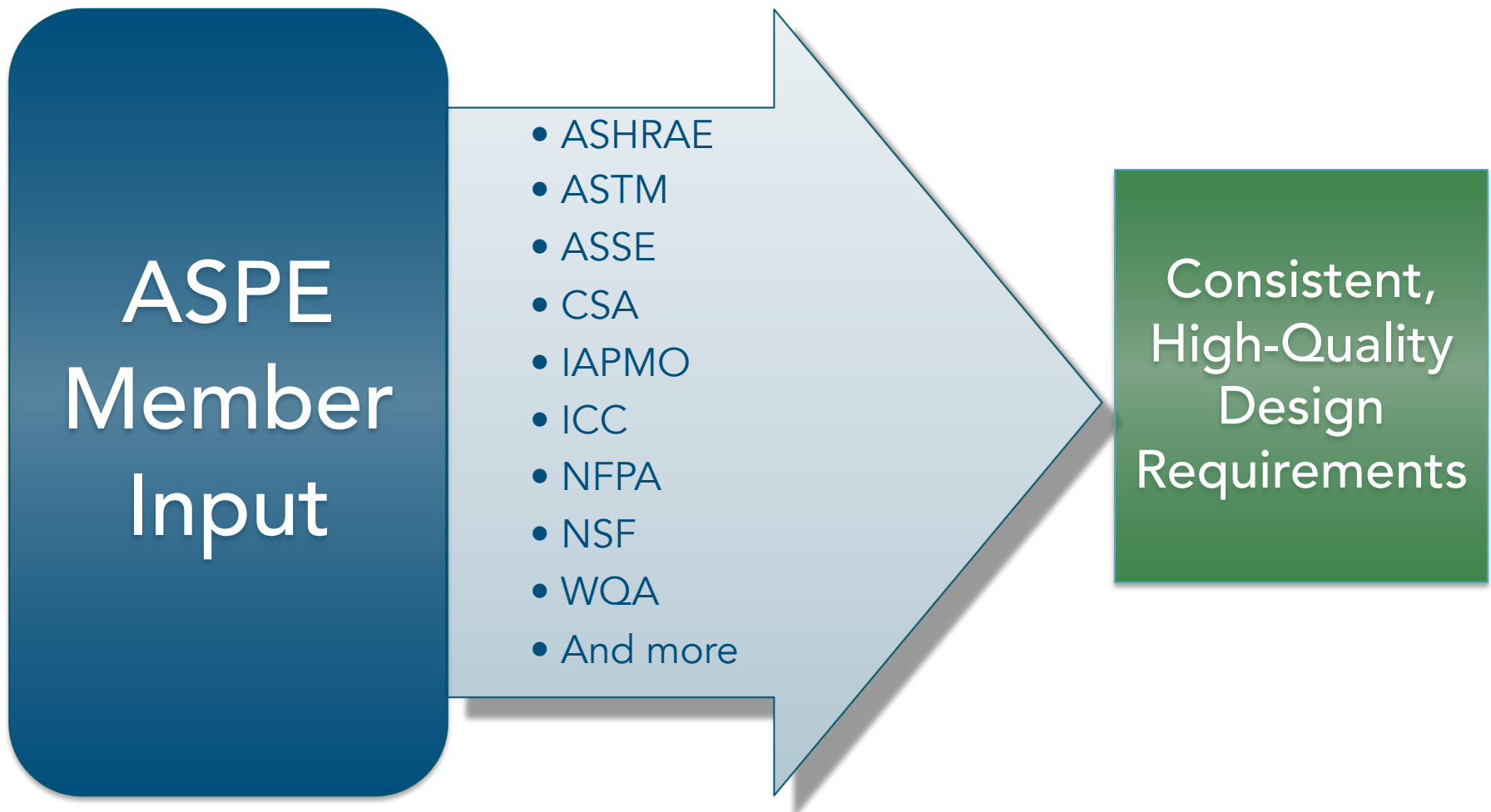

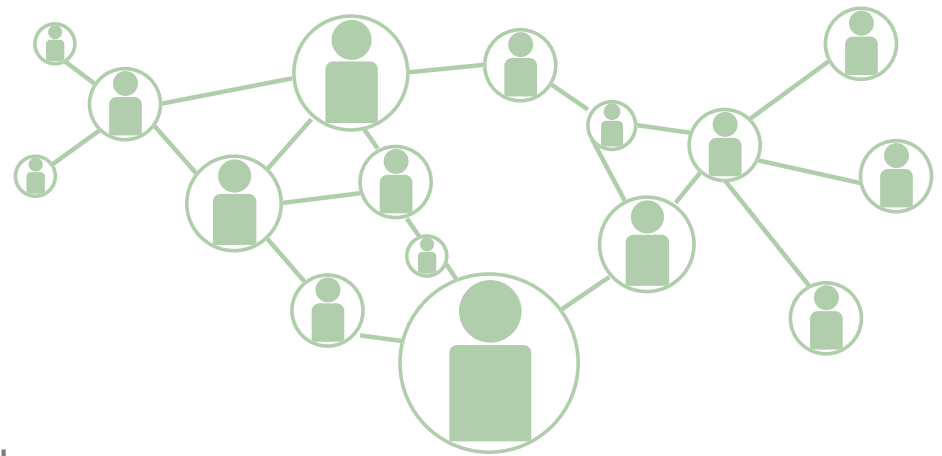
